This is our 7th Annual Draft Horse Show that is part of the Douglas County Fair. The Fair Board has invited us to be part of the Fair with Our Farm Class Exhibitors. Again this year there will be a "Special" monetary Award for the most unusual or unique Wagon in the "Draft Farm Team on the Rail" Class.

**Important: Must be member of CDHA, this is a must for insurance purposes.**

There are no stalling accommodations or overnight facilities available. This is an Indoor Arena, water will be available and we will have a short Lunch Break around 1:00 pm. Entry fees \$15.00 per class, except for Barrel Race (\$5.00 entry)

Entrants will be required to leave their area in the same condition as they found it.

**Draft Horse Show Rules:**

This Show is limited to Farm Class Entries only. All breeds of recognized draft horses, Draft Crosses, Draft Mules, grade or registered are eligible to compete.

**Junior Drivers** will be allowed to compete in (2) Two regular Classes ONLY. (NOTE: Log Skid Classes are not available to Junior Drivers) Each Junior Driver MUST be accompanied by an Adult (18 or older) experienced Driver.

**Horses/Mules** may be used once only in each of the Farm Team, Log Skid Single/Team, Single/Team Obstacle and Feed Team Race classes. Drivers can have two entries in a class but can't use same horse. If we have a large number of entries we may have to limit this.

**Class Particulars for all classes:**

Dress appropriately; headers should look neat and clean. This show will be a new first impression to a lot of non-draft people - let's look good. All classes will be judged on turnout and appearance as appropriate to the class, driving ability, willingness and response of the animal(s), teamwork between horses and driver. Any entry may be asked to leave the ring if judged a hazard to other participants.

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**(1D) Draft Farm Team on the Rail-** farm wagon, safe farm equipment, forecarts, wagonettes, hay wagons, and functional farm vehicles with fifth wheel gear allowed. One of the judging criteria is how well you portray a farm team as opposed to a fancy Show team. Clean farm harness or parade spotted harness allowed, no scotch collars, fancy martingales, etc. This will be an "on-the-rail" class but the Judge is permitted to ask for maneuvers as time allows. For example: backing, swinging the team, or driving a short pattern. **Please** bring your wagons, etc. Remember the "Special" Award. This is something else that will be new to the spectators.

**(2D) Feed Team Race-** We will use Sleds to load and unload the hay or straw bales. Sleds must be stopped before the "Swamper" leaves or gets back on the Wagon. "Swamper" must ride on the Sled when it is moving. Bales must be completely on the pallets. Contact with pallets, barrels or cones will result in additional penalties. Horses can walk or trot, canter or gallop will result in a penalty. 10 second penalties will be added to the finish times for each penalty.

**(3D) Single Draft Cart Obstacle-** Single Horse- Event is timed. Walk or trot only, time penalty for each instance of canter or gallop. Time penalties will be added for disturbing or knocking down obstacles. Going off course results in disqualification. Course maps will be available at check-in. You will be required to use our **Forecarts** for this Class.

**(4D) Team Draft Obstacle-** Teams will be required to use our **Forecarts** for this Class. Course and Rules the same for Team as they were for Single.

**(5D) Single Horse Log Skid-** Timed Event. Walk or Trot only, time penalty for each instance of canter or gallop. Time penalties will be added for disturbing or knocking down obstacles. Going off course will result in disqualification. Single Tree, log and chain provided. Course maps available at check-in.

**(6D) Team Log Skid-** Same Rules as Single, only with larger Log and modified course.

**(7D) Bareback Draft Horse Barrel Race** - open or closed bridle, bareback, animals 1500 pounds or more or drafts. Standard cloverleaf pattern (must cross path 3 times) can start right or left barrel, timed, will not have a starting run into the arena, will start already in the arena. Helmets encouraged for Adults, Youth must wear them. This class could be cut if we are running late. **(Class is for Driving Horses only)**
